Experience the Surf and Turf of Maine -the way life should be! This adventure starts with a lesson and morning of surfing at a Maine beach followed by a fresh lobster for lunch! The group will then head to Mount Blue State Park to set up camp and enjoy some hiking and a dip in Lake Webb. We then head north to the Adventure Bound Campground and spend the afternoon on their High Ropes Course. The following morning you will head to the Kennebec River for Guided Whitewater Rafting as your group navigates the rapids. Return to Huckins for a final free-time and campfire!

The itinerary and activities are subject to change depending on weather and outfitter restrictions.

- Sunday: **Check In @ 3pm on the Sportsfield**
Trip Leaders will meet you at Camp Huckins and provide an overview of the trip and answer any questions. Gear “shake-down”, swim tests and dinner in the dining hall. Campfire and prepare for morning departure.
- Tent Camping at Camp Huckins
- Monday: Travel to Old Orchard Beach for a surf lesson and then take to the waves! Eat a fresh lobster lunch and then travel to Mt Blue State Park. Cook dinner, play games and sing songs around the campfire.
- Tent Camping at Mt. Blue State Park
- Tuesday: After a hearty breakfast, hike Mt. Blue and then cool off with a dip in Lake Webb. Spend the evening preparing dinner, sharing stories and star gazing around the Campfire.
- Tent Camping at Mt. Blue State Park
- Wednesday: Travel north to Adventure Bound. Enjoy lunch at Adventure Bound and then spend the afternoon on the high ropes course. Set up Camp and settle in around the fire!
- Tent Camping at Adventure Bound, Caratunk.
- Thursday: It’s going to be a busy day, so time for a big buffet breakfast! We will then head to the Kennebec River for a day of guided Whitewater Rafting on class II-III rapids. The Kennebec is one of the most popular Whitewater spots in the East! Return to Camp for stories and dinner.
- Tent Camping at Adventure Bound, Caratunk.
- Friday: Pack up and travel back to Camp Huckins for free-time. Dinner in the dining hall and closing campfire.
