2019 No Other Year the Same

My 50th summer provided incredible memories and many wonderful alumni visitors to camp. All summer campers asked me “What was camp like 50 years ago? Did you go to camp with Nellie Huckins?” Although I am not quite as old as Nellie, I have had the amazing opportunity to help Camp Huckins grow and evolve to keep up with our ever-changing world. I remember learning to sail in yellow, tub-like widgeon sailboats. Our fleet has grown and changed over the years, and now our campers sail on pristine Sunfish sailboats and Hobi Wave catamarans. Our life jackets were uncomfortable foam belts, now our campers wear comfy, colorful PFDs that truly hold you upright when you tip over in a canoe or while taking your sailing test. Last summer we purchased a 2019 Ski Nautique to update our Small Crafts fleet. We have 2 boats devoted just to waterskiing and each weekday we schedule five hours of lessons, allowing almost 50 campers a day an opportunity to give waterskiing a try.

My fiftieth summer had many highlights—my favorite was adding an outdoor lap lane swimming area to our waterfront. I have always been an avid swimmer and I love swimming to the island, but being able to have our own swim meets at camp is truly special. During swimming lessons doing laps in the outside area is always very congested with everyone going different ways. The lap lanes will help spread campers out during swim lessons, giving us additional space to enjoy Lake Ossipee.

At the kitchen we installed a new fire hood system which vents all our cooking areas. We also put in new lights, a new ceiling and we resurfaced our kitchen floor. These much-needed improvements help keep our kitchen safer, cleaner and brighter for Joel and his kitchen staff. On the outside of the Dining Hall, our maintenance crew built four huge vegetable beds that grew tomatoes and cucumbers all summer. It is so fun to walk by the gardens and see tomatoes ripening before your eyes.

Our environmental education program, the Nature Hut, continues to grow and expand. Mae Van Rossum, our Nature Hut director, added opportunities for older campers, including the addition of overnight tent excursions. With more raised beds, we had more vegetables and herbs for Chef Joel to use in the Dining Hall. Picking vegetables and feeding the goats, sheep, bunnies, and chickens were daily highlights for campers.

The Junior Division campers and staff loved the new covered pavilion in their Division. The entire Division can gather rain or shine, and the picnic tables make it a great space to be together.

Our tennis courts have new pickle ball lines so we can have five pickle ball games going at one time. Pickle ball is becoming more and more popular and our family campers had quite the pickle ball tournament! Campers loved the

new mile that was added to our bike trail. It is great to be out in the woods on a safe trail with no cars and to be able to enjoy a wonderful part of our undeveloped property.

Thanks to longtime friend, past Huckins board member (one of our first women), former parent and grandparent, Gail Paine, and a grant from the Goldberg Foundation, we were able to install two new water bottle refill stations—one at the Dining Hall and one at the Waterfront. This is another wonderful way that camp continues to “go green”. Getting our campers and staff in the habit of carrying a water bottle cuts down on the daily use of plastic and keeps them hydrated.

The last line of the 2019 song sings “But it’s the inspiration most, that makes us love it so.” I have been inspired by so many amazing campers, staff, parents and all who enter the white gate. Fifty years have flown by and I am so thankful to all of you for your commitment and dedication to this special place we call Camp Huckins. Your support of our Annual fund and our Scholarship Fund is crucial to us all. Growing our Endowment Fund will continue to support camp and our scholarships for future years. Making camp available to all, regardless of one’s ability to pay, continues to be a priority for our Board and Leadership. In 2019, 278 campers received scholarship support.

Thank you to all our volunteers, staff families, friends and donors for helping us keep Camp Huckins constant and true. I look forward to sharing my final summer at camp with you all.

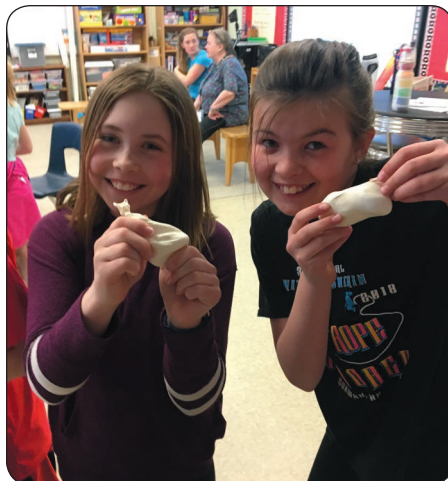

Master Planning

The Huckins Board of Directors remains committed to sustaining and developing our facilities through long range planning. This process is guided by a 2017 comprehensive ten-year Master Plan.

This season, in addition to several annual capital projects, we completed two projects from our most recent Master Plan. We built a new pavilion in the Junior Division. The pavilion design was based on the popular Leadership Division Pavilion and provides our Junior campers with a covered common space to gather. We also completed a new laundry and storage facility located behind the Kitchen. The laundry facility provides a much-needed area for Kitchen storage and staff laundry.

In addition, the Master Planning Committee helped to create a comprehensive survey of parents, staff, Senior Division campers and Leadership Division campers. The survey content addressed the overall camp experience with a focus on buildings and facilities. We had a high response rate, receiving more than 1100 surveys and over 2000 "write-in" comments. This valuable feedback has allowed the committee to focus on specific areas that are highly valued by the entire camp community. An article highlighting the areas of focus will be included in the spring *Huckonian*.

In 2020, the Master Planning Committee will begin working on the plan for renovating and restoring the

Program Lodge, reimagining the Program Office, and renovating the Sports Complex. In addition, we anticipate breaking ground in September 2020 on new staff housing. This new multi-unit building will replace the three current staff bungalows. The new construction will create a staff village below the Craft Shop and provide Camp with additional pre- and post-camp program handicapped-accessible housing.

First Annual Staff Auction

Last June during Staff Week, we held our first annual Staff Auction. The theme was "Send a Girl to Camp." Each staff member was asked to donate an item or a service. We had a "Movie Night Gift Basket", sailing lessons, fun t-shirts, pizza delivery, ukulele lessons, friendship bracelets and so many more items—85 donations in all. At lunch staff purchased tickets and then at dinner they put them in the corresponding baskets. Staff kids picked tickets out of the baskets. It was a fun evening and raised over \$1400 for a scholarship. Thank you to all of our staff who participated. We are looking forward to the Second Annual Staff Auction in June 2020!

Interview with Harold Cook

Late in January I had the opportunity to sit down with Harold Cook, former Board member, land manager, forester, advisor, and friend to the CCYMCA/ Camp Huckins to learn more about the special features and history of the expansive, natural property upon which our beloved camp operates. Harold lives in South Tamworth and he owns and operates Greenleaf Products which helps landowners responsibly manage wooded/forested properties. Harold has been working with Huckins for approximately 30 years, thinning out trees and advising us on best practices to keep our land safe and healthy.

Camp Huckins sits on 350 acres in the middle of the Ossipee Pine Barrens Ecosystem. This unique area of New Hampshire is home to pitch pines, scrub oak, shrublands and wetlands. Within this special forest live several rare species of moth, butterflies and birds. The Barrens ecosystem, created thousands of years ago by melting glaciers, spreads across four towns in Carroll County and are characterized by flat, sandy soil with many ponds and lakes.

On our property, there are three main tree species - red pines, pitch pines and white pines. In the 1960's, the U.S. Department of Agriculture funded the planting of thousands of small seedlings to help re-generate the forest after a forest fire in the late 1940's. Forty years later, in the 1980's Harold became involved with Huckins and was asked to look at our forests. He reported to the Board at the time that our trees, planted as seedlings, were now



overcrowded and a potential fire hazard to camp. Harold and his crews began to carefully manage and cut the trees on our property. By thinning out the trees periodically and taking down any diseased trees, Harold helps keep Camp Huckins safe from forest fires and create a healthy asset for the future. The forested trees are sold for lumber and other wood products and the proceeds go to our operating budget for special projects and facilities maintenance. This past fall, our woods were forested, and the proceeds will help create a third mile of trails for our mountain biking program!

As a board member, Harold was also instrumental in convincing other Board members in 1998 to buy an 88-acre lot adjacent to Camp. That lot completed the triangle between Pequawket Trail Road and Huckins Road and has kept Camp Huckins buffered from additional development. Today, that area is used by Camp for our horseback and mountain bike riding programs.

Harold Cook is one of the amazing people who helps CCYMCA/Camp Huckins be a good steward of this place that we all hold so dear.

Huckins also received four (4) trailer loads of wood chips for landscaping in addition to 4000+ board feet of logs to be sawed out for lumber to be used at camp.
