#### \*\*\*\* PLEASE NOTE NEW ARRIVAL DAY/TIMES\*\*\*\*

All campers will arrive on Sundays and depart on Saturdays. This change is to allow for additional cleaning between sessions. Arrivals will be staggered, organized alphabetically into groups. This will support social distancing and reduce waiting during the check-in process. More details will be available about this new process in our Spring information sheet.

#### **TUITION FEES:** \$1,765- \$2,100 (plus a non-refundable \$100 Registration Fee)

Camp Huckins believes that the benefits of our high-quality summer camp experience should be available to every child. Realizing that families have differing abilities to pay, Camp Huckins offers a voluntary three tier pricing program. More information will be available with the online registration. All children will have the same experience no matter which tier a family is able to pay. The tier selected by a family will be kept confidential. In addition, camperships are awarded based on financial need or other extenuating circumstances. Applications for financial aid can be requested when registering.

The person who submits the application is responsible for payment of all fees. We cannot make deductions for delay in arrival or leaving before scheduled date. 50% of tuition is due March 1, with the balance due by May 1<sup>st</sup>. We also offer a monthly payment plan beginning February 1. *Think about your payment plans now- partial payments will not be accepted after May 1st.* If payment in full is not received by May 1st the spot will be given to a child on the waitlist.

**COVID Fee:** We anticipate additional requirements to open safely in 2021, but do not know all specifics at this time. A COVID fee may be assessed to cover the cost of testing and other extraordinary requirements to safely open. We will notify families in early April of the COVID fee. We will do all we can to keep this fee as low as possible, and financial aid will be available to ensure all registered campers can attend.

**WAIT LIST:** In the event that your child is placed on the Wait List, you will receive an acknowledgement. We will contact you as space becomes available. If you wish to remove your child from the Wait List, please contact the Registrar as soon as you make that decision.

**CANCELLATION POLICIES:** If you need to cancel your camper's registration please notify the Registrar as soon as possible. Camp Huckins has a **no-refund** policy, for both registration fees and tuition payments apart from medical refunds. If the camp season is cancelled, all tuition payments will be refunded.

**MEDICAL INFORMATION:** All campers must furnish a completed Health Form online. More information will be forthcoming about our online health and medication ordering.

**SPECIAL PROGRAMS:** Other expenses that may be incurred by campers are listed below. Please read carefully, as some restrictions do apply.

- **HORSEBACK RIDING:** Available to all campers who have completed 4th grade. On average riding will be available one time per week (dependent on weather and number of signups) and the \$30.00 fee is per lesson.
- **WATERSKIING:** Available to any camper who has passed our Outside Area Swim Test. The \$18.00 fee is per lesson.

**CAMP BANK:** All charges (such as Horseback Riding and Waterskiing) will be charged to your Camper's account. Campers who would like to try everything normally will spend around \$100.00 (less for campers who do not ride or waterski). "W"s and "CIT"s will spend about \$150. The total will be charged to your card on file at the end of the session.

Campers are placed in Divisions according to the **grade completed in June**. Campers must have completed the third grade prior to attending camp. Each Division includes the following Grades:

- JUNIOR: 3RD & 4TH Graders, and 5TH Graders WHO ARE NEW TO CAMP  
HUCKINS
- MIDDLER: Returning 5TH Graders, and 6TH Graders
- SENIORS 7TH and 8TH Graders
- LEADERSHIP: 9TH/10th Graders and CITs (Counselors in Training are by invitation, only)

\*\*Please note to accommodate all campers that were enrolled for the summer of 2020, housing may be across divisions, but the programming will be by the divisions above during the 2021 season.\*\*

**TRUNKS:** We are very strict on the size of trunks allowed in the cabin. The size is as follows: 32" x 18" x 13 1/2". Please do not bring anything higher than 13 1/2" as it must fit under the bunk. If the trunk is oversize, it will have to be unpacked and sent home with the parents. Anything larger presents a safety hazard.

**CHESTS OF DRAWERS:** must also conform to specific dimensions, which are as follows: 15 5/8" x 12 5/8" x 27", only one per camper. We ask that you please adhere to these sizes in order to make your camper's first hours at camp less stressful.
