51 YEARS OF HUCKINS HISTORY

Jody Hutchinson Skelton

Embracing change is a common Vespers theme at Camp. On Sunday and Wednesday nights, girls in their pajamas gather as quiet cabin groups at the Lodge. Campers take their seats and sway together cross-legged on the floor, pastel-colored xeroxed lyrics sheets in hand and all eyes are on the group in front as they sing favorite folk and pop songs. Skits are performed, poems read, and songs are sung; each element of the Vespers is thoughtfully stitched together to bring to the community a message that change is a good, necessary, natural part of life. Change may be hard, but it can be embraced if done with care, bravery, enthusiasm and love.

Depending on which decade you attended camp, your Vespers sheet might have the lyrics to David Bowie's "Changes," "Landslide" by Fleetwood Mac or The Chicks, or "Rivers and Roads" by The Head and the Heart. Just as your Vespers sheet might contain different songs, the changes that you notice at Camp—whether between summers or between your last summer and a visit decades later—may be different. However, Camp Huckins and what truly makes Camp "camp", never changes. Girls jump off the tower, learn to paddle, sail and craft and stand on benches and sing their hearts out. And, most importantly, girls learn to make friends and embrace their authentic selves.

Jody Hutchinson Skelton experienced and led Huckins through many changes in her 51 years at camp. The list is long, wide and deep, Jody can describe in detail all of the changes whether large or small. There have been physical changes like the building of the ropes course, the addition of cabins, and the construction of the sports dome and chapel. There have been programmatic changes like adding



Big Change between 2nd and 3rd sessions, changing campers' banquet to the camper talent show, and adding to the variety of themed program days over the decades. No matter the change, the motivation for it has always been to support Huckins' priorities and improve the camper experience, which are forever intertwined.

The Leadership Division is one change that Jody describes as the most impactful during her tenure. Zaven Vorperian, director from 1964 to 1989, was the first to

propose the idea of a Leadership Division which moved the 9th grade "W" Program out of the Senior Division and combined it with the CIT program. Jody worked with Zaven and then with Judy Snell (1989-2003) to further this idea, and the completion of the Alden Howard Leadership Division in 2012 brought this vision to fruition. According to Jody, "completing the Alden Howard Leadership Division in 2012 was critical to our focus on leadership growth in our girls and young women. The Huckins legacy of home-grown counselors, program staff and Division Leaders is a direct result of this emphasis. Empowering young women to step outside their comfort zones and to take leadership roles is at the heart of our mission."

Camp celebrates the little things, which, as it ends up, are actually the most important things. The whole camp

shouting an “Alamen” for a camper’s first jump off the tower can be life changing. The bravery it took to jump, followed by collective acknowledgement of the achievement by others, is the backbone of Huckins culture. Recognizing accomplishments in ourselves and others is what Huckins is all about. Jody describes recognition as one of the most important things we can do at Camp and one of the things that will never change. The magic of an award card—writing it out, announcing it, cheering for it and receiving it—can never be underestimated.

When asked about her biggest accomplishments as camper, counselor and director Jody didn’t hesitate. As a camper it was learning how to waterski and playing on the camp softball team. As a counselor, it was her first change day when campers were saying goodbye and didn’t want to leave. That moment solidified her desire to work with children. And, finally, it was the many times as a Director when she stood at the back of the Lodge during Vespers and as campers were filing out at the end, a camper would stop, give her a hug and say “thank you”. “They weren’t thanking me for Vespers, but they were thanking me for camp.”

Society has changed a great deal over the last 51 years, but Huckins has stayed true to what is most important: giving girls opportunities to learn to trust themselves, to make new friends, and to learn how to get along in a group setting. The rituals, traditions and ceremonies at Camp anchor the community and provide stability during change.

The Candlelight ceremony, aside from moving from the waterfront to the chapel, has remained the same since Jody’s first summer in 1970. Girls gather together, acknowledging the importance of each other and their shared experiences before leaving the next morning.

The magic of the Huckster ceremony remains even though the green Huckster dangle bracelet changed to a silver loon necklace. Jody explained that

during the first year of the new Huckster necklace, a wise counselor had the idea of dipping the necklaces into the lake after the ceremony. This created a new magic around the Huckster ceremony which helped ease the change. People will embrace change if you can work together to make it happen and have them join with you to make magic around the change.”

Jody stated “With Heather Kiley as our new Executive Director, Carroll County YMCA/Camp Huckins is prepared to continue thriving and to meet the challenges of the future.” Times will change, but Camp and the feelings we have for Camp will remain constant and true.

Our amazing staff stepped into the challenge with their positive, can-do approach to problem solving. They have worked so hard all year and carried us through. The board created a COVID committee and met often to guide and support the many decisions that involved reacting quickly

and strategically to what felt like constantly changing guidance. Board members and many volunteers stepped up to meet increased demand for everything from oversight of planning and projects necessary to meet public health regulations, to fundraising and development needs, to how best to fund operations and react to economic uncertainties. Families and donors were understanding and generous. Thank you to everyone who continues to support all of our work. A special thanks to Eleni Eliades who completed her term as board chair and to Leslie Guenther who cycled off the board after many years of dedicated service.

Reacting to the pandemic was not the only focus for board work this year. The board voted unanimously this summer to set diversity, equity and inclusion as a strategic priority. We continue to learn and explore how best to ensure that Huckins leads by example and with humility towards more diversity, a grounding of all decisions in equity and broad inclusion. Jill Lyons's Huckster Project

Each spring all our new Hucksters receive a letter asking them to consider a donation to Camp in honor of their 5th summer at Camp. Girls are encouraged to donate money that they have earned, perhaps through a part-time job, by babysitting, or by doing chores for family or friends, and we ask that they write us to share how they earned their money.

This year, Huckster Jill Lyons reached out to Jody and Heather to ask if she might do a fundraiser through Customink, an online printing company that allows individuals to create fundraisers and sell customized clothing and products. Her idea was to create a beach towel to sell to the Huckins community through social media. Jill designed the towels using the Huckins 1928 logo and set a goal to sell 150 towels. We posted the fundraiser on some of our Huckins' affiliated social media platforms and the rest is history! 426 towels and \$4845 dollars later, the results of the month-long fundraiser far exceeded Jill's original goal.

When asked what advice she might give to future Hucksters, Jill encourages them to think outside the box as they consider their own Huckster projects and donations. "You should never underestimate how much people love Camp!"

Although we were unable to hold our traditional camp sessions this past summer, the Huckins community remained engaged, connected, and of course, rugged, wholesome and true. In creative Huckins fashion, campers and staff quickly adapted to an online camp format, eager to see new and old Nellie faces during daily Zoom sessions and pre-recorded instructionals. Ever present flexibility of both campers and staff kept the Huckins spirit alive and strong amidst the pandemic.

Huckins@Home welcomed four sessions of campers who joined in from across the country. Campers actively connected with counselors and friends to learn new crafts and activities, sing favorite camp songs, and join weekly evening vespers. Some of our reimagined program day favorites included Disney Day (where we all built Fairy Houses with Tinker Bell and Captain Hook), the Women's Empowerment Lunch (when campers dressed as their favorite role-models), as well as Game Day, Pride Lunch, and the ever-popular Harry Potter Day. We all know that the Huckins Spirit is "deep in our hearts, down in our knees, and all over me," but this summer we learned that the Huckins spirit is also sparkling through our computer screens, connecting us all from our own homes.

This summer, we also had the special opportunity to spread the Huckins spirit to a broader community through Virtual Kids Kamp for Ultimate Kronos Group (UKG). Onsite Huckins staff ran a parallel virtual camp for children of

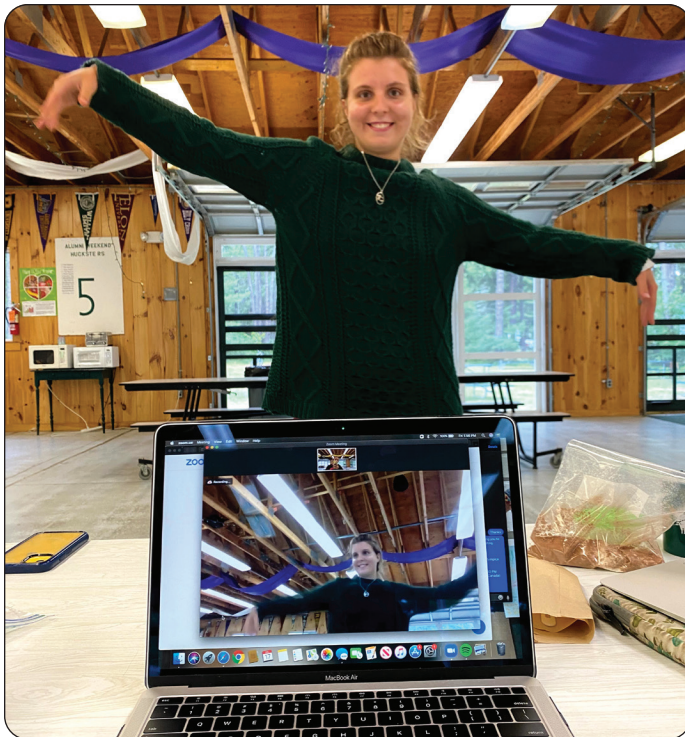

UKG employees. Counselors provided four sessions of live and pre-recorded content and multiple daily Zoom cabin meetings to UKG campers around the country. UKG campers loved the STEM challenges, virtual escape rooms, and book clubs, as well as learning to juggle and to create an erupting volcano.

In addition to providing daily remote camp experiences, both onsite and remote staff spent time evaluating and strengthening the leadership program, as well as considering and redefining Huckins' approach to Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion. The entire staff connected regularly in virtual meetings to discuss how better to align Camp's practices with our core values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility. Melissa Lawlor, the Director of Equity and Inclusion at Brewster Academy led two DEI trainings this summer, and Executive Director Heather Kiley facilitated conversations and additional training sessions. The entire Camp Huckins staff—from Junior Counselors to Senior Leadership—are committed to working to improve and grow in these areas so that we can become a more inclusive organization for all campers and staff members.

Finally, on-site staff were hard at work to prepare Camp for the return of campers in 2021. Staff tackled numerous projects, including cleaning the bike trails and ropes course paths, painting cabins, sheds and tables, building a new gaga ball pit at the sports field, taking inventory in the camp store, and creating and installing a new inclusion sign at the Camp entrance. After an unconventional yet wonderful Summer of 2020, the staff is ready and eager to welcome campers back in June of 2021.

Feeding the Community

For the last eight years, feeding the Huckins community has been my mission. From 2013 to 2019 that was an enormous but mostly straightforward task. Every summer, once the kinks of first session smoothed themselves out, the work of feeding our community became a groove that could be counted on like the changing of the seasons. Three times a day the dining hall filled and emptied, the food came in, the food went out. Our team became a well-oiled machine that performed the kitchen “dance” like seasoned pros. For nine weeks, it didn’t matter what day it was or even what year it was. The only thing that mattered was what the menu said.

Then 2020 arrived and as we all know; it became clear that this was no ordinary year. The routines that had been in place for years, decades even, were quickly erased. Feeding the Huckins community suddenly looked very different. Our on-site community shrank by close to 90% and my staff went from 14 to 4. As we readied the kitchen to feed our Huckins at Home staff, we wondered if we could use our facility to feed more than just 40-50 people. Was there a need in our local community? After reaching out to our friends at the Ossipee Dinner Bell, we were put in touch with the NH Food Bank and it was determined that, yes, there was a need. The NH Food Bank, in conjunction with the USDA, traditionally

works with schools to provide the Summer Food Service Program but in 2020 the local schools did not have the staff to continue delivering meals to families in need as they had so diligently done since the start of the pandemic. We decided that this was something that we could take on once the school year ended. We are grateful to the Robert and Dorothy Goldberg Charitable Foundation for allowing us to redirect funds from a previously awarded grant towards this effort.

Feeding “our community” took on new meaning as we started providing breakfast and lunch five days a week for any family that needed it. With the help of our incredible volunteer drivers, we brought meals to pick up sites in Madison, Tamworth, Freedom and Conway. Anyone was welcome to come and pick up a meal, no questions asked. On average we were able to provide 400 meals a week to our neighboring communities. Our walk-in refrigerator, normally filled with enough food to feed 500 people, was suddenly filled with coolers and ice packs of all shapes and sizes waiting to be loaded and delivered. Our practiced ways of past summers were quickly replaced with learning how to package a whole lot of food-to go and how to translate our experience in crafting handmade, nutritious food in mass quantities to smaller, portable, storable items. We are so grateful to have been able to use our skills and our kitchen to meet a need with our local families and thankful for our small staff that so seamlessly switched gears.

2020 will certainly have a notorious legacy, but in the Huckins kitchen it will also be remembered as the year that we broadened our view of our community. Our Huckins philosophy of service to others expanded as we served over 3000 meals beyond our celebrated white gates.

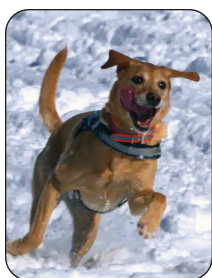

Navigating the Re-Opening of Camp

On a warm July day this past summer, Camp Huckins looked very different than it would on a regular day in a typical “camping” summer. While some of our on-site staff were busy preparing for their Huckins @ Home virtual sessions, our dedicated Kitchen team was hard at work putting together meals to be distributed to local families. We all felt a sense of pride about the good work we were doing, yet at the same time we recognized the careful planning and preparation required in anticipation of welcoming campers back for the 2021 summer season.

Since that day back in July, our planning expanded and gained momentum as we continue to work with national, state and local experts to shape guidance and best practices for re-opening. There is no doubt that Camp will look a little different, but the feelings, traditions, and memories made will be just as important as ever.

The Huckins Re-Opening Task Force has met weekly since July and continues to re-imagine all facets of camp life during the time of COVID. In conjunction with the COVID committee of the Board of Directors, the Task Force has worked diligently to assess all parts of the Huckins operation, considering and reworking policies, procedures, and practices in order to open camp safely. From cabin set-

up and daily schedules to health care and food service, this group has drafted plans for a safe and successful return to camp. These draft plans are currently being reviewed by the Huckins Medical Advisory Group, an alumni group comprised of physicians, nurses and an epidemiologist.

Here is a snapshot of improvements you can expect this summer:

Bathroom Improvements

- One way traffic flow
- Improved ventilation with added exit and additional screening
- Metered faucets
- Interior floor matting to improve sanitation and cleanliness

Revised Change Day Procedures (including Camp Store)

- Drive through drop off including testing, health screening and luggage drop
- Options to pre-order Camper Care Bundles from our online store. These will then be delivered and waiting on your camper's bunk!

Food Service and Dining Hall

- Improved ventilation in the Dining Hall
- Addition of a large 40' by 100' tent to allow for ample spacing between tables
- Staff served buffet lines, including one way traffic flow
- Body thermometers, located on entry, for daily screening

Healthcare Improvements

- Additional Registered Nurses on staff
- Surveillance testing program for all staff and campers
- Renovations to our health center to allow for more isolation space
- Revised sick call and medication administration process
- On-site, symptomatic COVID-19 testing capability

Cabin Improvements

- Additional exits on all cabins for improved ventilation
- Exhaust fans in all cabins.



Staffing

- Modifications to staff training and schedules to prioritize social/emotional supports for campers and staff as we return to community living for the first time since COVID
- Additional custodial staff to improve cleanliness and sanitation
- Additional administrative staff focused on camper and staff well-being, including a new Director of Community Life and a Program Department Division Leader

Other Facility Improvements

- Renovations to the Sports Complex for improved ventilation and acoustics
- Additional temporary handwashing and bathroom facilities across Camp
- Designated Hand Sanitizer Stations across Camp
- More tents across camp for added outdoor program space

2020 Summary of Financial Position

The 2020 fiscal year was arguably the most challenging year in CCYMCA/Camp Huckins history. The decision to cancel on-site programs and to refund all program tuitions left Huckins in a vulnerable position. The staff and Board of Directors collaborated to explore multiple funding models to ensure Huckins could not only survive the pandemic but also retain our staff, actively serve our community, and end the year in a position of strength to re-open in 2021.

This financial summary provides an overview of how operations were funded in 2020 and our operating expenses. Highlighted throughout the Huckonian and Annual Report is the record giving to the Huckins Fund (our annual fund)—both in terms of dollars raised AND in terms of the number of donors. We are grateful to camp families that donated back tuition dollars, staff and alumni that donated their time and made additional gifts, to new donors, and donors that increased their giving in support of

our work. Without your support, we could not have pivoted so quickly to serve our community in new ways. Thank you.

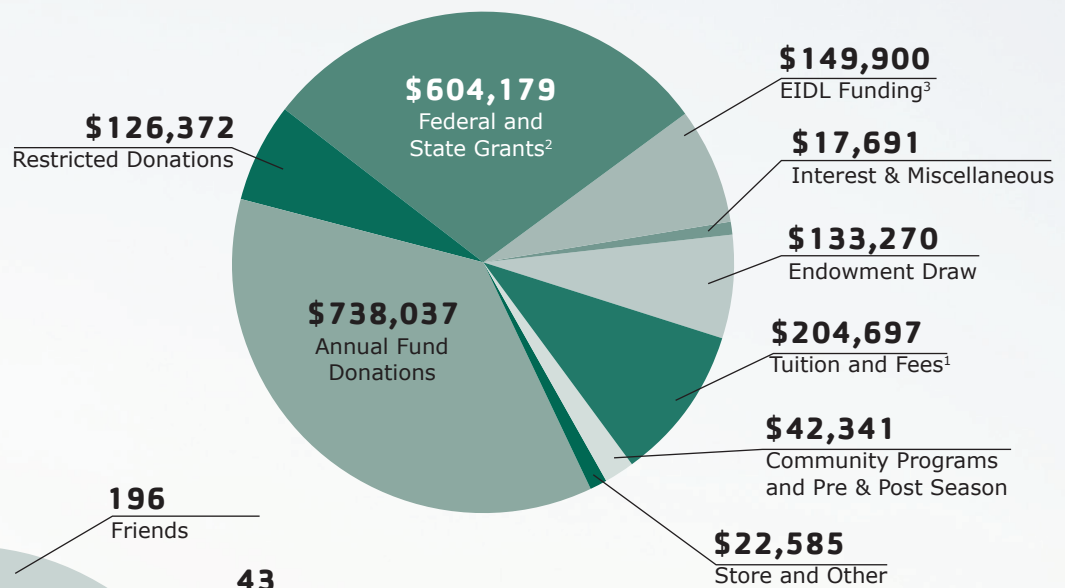
We also want to highlight the efforts of Board Members and staff in securing federal and state grant funds. Securing these funds, including PPP funds, required us to learn quickly and act thoughtfully. All 2020 PPP loans were forgiven. The only debt CCYMCA/Camp Huckins took on was the Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL). This loan of \$149,900 was accepted and specifically designated to fund COVID related facility improvements to support 2021 re-opening. State and private grant dollars supported the summer local food delivery, operating expenses, and our first virtual After S'Cool clubs for NH middle school students.

Navigating the financial complexities of 2020 was a challenge that required the help of the entire CCYMCA/Camp Huckins community. We are so proud and grateful.

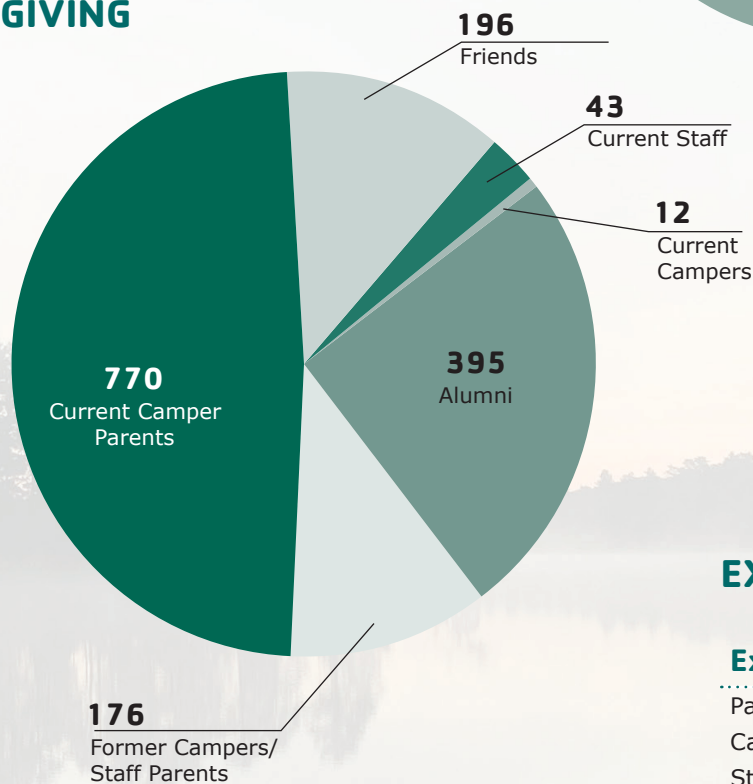

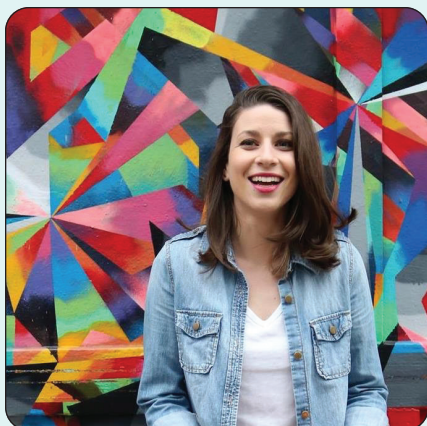
